Dear friends and compatriots,

Following our letter of October 2010, we have the great pleasure to confirm the IXth Euro-Armenian Easter Games of UAS which will take place in Geneva from 22 to 25 April 2011.

As you know, this IXth edition of the UAS games will be a particularly significant and exceptional one. Indeed, by a matter of chance, the 24th of April 2011, the Armenian Genocide Memorial Day coincides with the last day of the tournament.

Taking advantage of this extraordinary opportunity, the Organizing Committee of the games has decided to organize the biggest Armenian Diaspora youth gathering in Geneva for the commemoration of the 96th anniversary of the Armenian genocide.

For this occasion, Geneva will be taken over by the Armenian youth from all over Europe, who, will commemorate with dignity and honor, by a torchlight walk to the United Nations and speeches.

This mobilization will prove to the world that young Armenians have not forgotten their past, that four years before the 100th anniversary of the Armenian genocide, they are more than ever present and united, claiming all as one, justice and the recognition of the Armenian genocide.

Dear friends and compatriots, what better way than sport to get together, to defy one another and yet remain united and stand together in our struggle?

The tournament disciplines are: Basketball (women and men teams), Indoor Football (men), Volleyball (mixed-women and men) and Table Tennis (women and men) and Chess (women and men/adults and children).

We kindly ask you to inform us of your decision to participate in the games as soon as possible, however not later than **28 February 2011**, mentioning the disciplines you wish to register for and the number of participants. This registration should follow not later than **15th of March 2011** by the payment of **the total amount of the participation fee** and completed and fully detailed registration forms.

Participants of team games should not exceed eight (8) athletes and one (1) trainer in addition to one (1) head of delegation for each club / association. Each team may only have one (1) non-Armenian player.

The participation fee for each athlete amounts to **CHF 390.- (Swiss Francs)** . The price includes 3 overnight stays with breakfast in a double room at RAMADA PARK HOTEL (75-77, Ave. Louis-Casaï, 1216 Genève – Cointrin), Saturday night - 23 April - dinner , Sunday night – 24th of April – “Grande Soirée” and 2 lunch packs.

For guests accompanying athletes, the participation fee amounts to **CHF 590.- (Swiss Francs)** per guest, for a double room and **CHF 650.- (Swiss Francs)** per guest for a single room. The price includes 3 overnight stays with breakfast, Saturday night - 23 April - dinner and Sunday night – 24th of April – “Grande Soirée”.
